Come to the Moora Moora Strawbale Summer School

We are running a two day practical workshop based at the Moora Moora Community.

The workshops will run on the 10th - 11th of January 2009 and 24th - 25th of January 2009. They will begin on Saturday morning at 10am and finish on Sunday at 6pm.

Your facilitator

Jeremy Shub lives at Moora Moora, a 617 acre Cooperative near Healesville. He has recently received a Certificate of Occupancy for his owner built Strawbale house. He lives with his wife and two children. Jeremy has worked on many different Strawbale projects around Victoria. His is currently supporting two owner builders at Moora Moora. Jeremy has been in education for most of his adult life. In his spare time he is a father, husband and sculptor.

All 30 houses at Moora Moora have been owner built. There are all types of techniques and architectural styles. A variety of houses will be open for inspection. We will also be able to meet the owner builders.
